Students at West Chester University are strongly encouraged to complete their education by participating in co-curricular experiences. The Co-Curricular Transcript is an official record of these experiences, endorsed by the University, that documents student learning beyond academics.

Focus Area. An area of co-curricular study. Focus areas include Career Readiness, Community Engagement, Health and Wellness, Involvement and Leadership, and Social Justice.

Semester/Year. Timeframe for when the experience and learning occurred.

Experience. Co-curricular program or experience the student participated in. Co-curricular programs and experiences are typically offered outside the classroom. These may include formal training programs, conferences, and other experiential learning opportunities (e.g., internships, experiences abroad, performances, leadership roles).

Learning Outcome. Co-curricular programs are designed around the seven goals for student learning (listed below). A [rubric](#) has been created for each learning goal.
