If you are in San José and you want to do something that is unusual and fun, but without the long drive, then the Monte Zurquí Canopy is the perfect tour for you.

Monte Zurquí is a great place located at only 15 minutes from San José, surrounded by beautiful landscapes and lush vegetation where you will experience a great adventure. Begin with a Canopy Tour that includes 2 extreme games, continue with a rappel from a 30 feet high suspension bridge and end with a 656 yard Superman Zip Line, reaching an estimated speed of 44mph.
