

MINOR IN MUSIC

Curriculum Code: Q057

This program is geared toward Liberal Arts students with an interest in music. To be enrolled, students must be approved by audition and have the permission of both their major advisor and the School of Music Undergraduate Coordinator.

The Minor Field in Music requires a program of 18-19 semester hours of study as follows:

I. Required Courses (11-12 credits)

MTC 112 Theory of Music I	3
MTC 114 Aural Activities I	2

One of the following 3 credit courses: 3

- MHL 121 Fine Arts Music
- * MHL 210 Music History I
- * MHL 211 Music History II
- * MHL 212 Music History III

*Permission of the Music History Department Chairperson or the Music Minor Advisor is required. Other MHL courses are not acceptable.

Chorus, Orchestra, or Band (2 semesters) 1 to 2

PIA 181 Piano Class I	1
PIA 182 Piano Class II	1

(Students who demonstrate the needed facility may be excused from PIA 181/182 and must use the credits in the elective category.)

II. Electives (7 credits)

Any music course, selected under advisement, for which the student meets the pre-requisite. This may include up to four semesters of vocal, keyboard and/or instrumental studio instruction by permission of the applied chair. If the student takes the maximum number of private lessons allowable, at least one of the course numbers must be above the beginning level.
