AGENCIES/ DEPARTMENTS</p>	<p>www.grants.gov <i>Grants.gov is a Federal government system that was created to readily allow organizations and individuals to find and apply for competitive grant opportunities from all Federal grant-making agencies. Grants.gov is the single access point for over 1000 grant programs sponsored by the 26 Federal grant-making agencies. Grants.gov allows you to conduct basic searches; searches by programs/subjects of study, and searches by Federal agency. You can subscribe to receive current grant opportunities in your e-mail address. In addition to your individual search of federal grant opportunities, please note that the dedicated staff members of OSRFD are always accessible to assist faculty members to conduct prospect research by successfully customizing your specific research interests and/or scholarly activities to an appropriate funding agency's guidelines.</i></p>
