- Skills to prepare for their career, including interviewing, networking, and preparing for a new job.

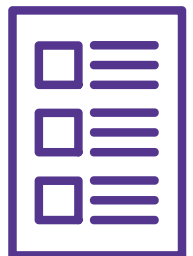


How can LinkedIn Learning videos help me?
