2022 WCU 1871 Award Application

Established in 2018, the 1871 Award recognizes up to 71 West Chester University juniors and seniors who are high-achieving in academics, leadership, community engagement and career readiness. Applicants must be undergraduate students who have completed a minimum of 60 credits (at least 30 must have been earned at WCU), and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25. Applicants must also be in good conduct standing. By submitting this application, you are consenting to have your academic and conduct records reviewed by a member of the selection committee.

Applicants will be reviewed on the following criteria: Academics (25%); Leadership (25%); Community Engagement (25%) and Career Readiness (25%).

The application consists of four sections: 1) Student personal information; 2) Short answer questions; 3) Resume or curriculum vitae, and; 4) Letters of recommendation. It is recommended that applicants draft their responses to the short answer questions in a Word document and then paste those responses into the relevant fields.

The deadline to apply is Sunday, November 6, 2022 at 11:45 pm. Applicants will be notified of their status in January 2023, and those selected will be honored at an awards ceremony on Thursday, April 13, 2023.
