- 5. ENG 560, Locating Literature

III. Electives (12 semester hours)

Students are to select three <u>electives</u> from among courses in the following categories: General Topics and Theory, English Literature, American Literature, Comparative Literature, Composition and Rhetoric, and Research and Special Topics. For course categories, see the *Graduate Catalog* or *Handbook for English Graduate Students*.

Students are to select one <u>free elective</u> chosen from among all ENG categories, including those listed in the paragraph above and in the categories of Language, Teaching Skills, Creative Writing, and PWP courses (The Pennsylvania Writing and Literature Project).

V. Additional Requirements

ENG 500 and ENG 501 are to be taken before the completion of 12 semester hours of graduate credit. (6 semester hours)

American literature requirement: At least one course must be taken in American literature. Although it is not limited to these, "American literature" includes courses in the literature of various populations that contribute to the diversity of U.S. culture: African-American, Native American, and Asian-American, among others.

Non-canonical requirement: At least two courses must be taken in topics addressing writing, literature, and/or pedagogy relating to under-represented groups.
