

DPA Dissertation Committee Approval Form

The responsibility for the quality and completion of a dissertation rests with the student, the Dissertation Supervisor and Committee Chairperson, and two committee members. The Dissertation Supervisor and at least one committee member must be part of the West Chester University faculty. Each committee must be approved by the DPA Program Director before a student is able to enroll in DPA 804.

Each committee member has a vote to approve or disapprove a dissertation. In order for the dissertation to be considered approved, no more than one negative vote can be registered, and the Dissertation Supervisor must vote in the affirmative. No formal presentation or defense is required. A qualified individual from a different program or from outside the University may serve on the committee as a third or fourth member as approved by the Dissertation Supervisor and DPA Program Director.
