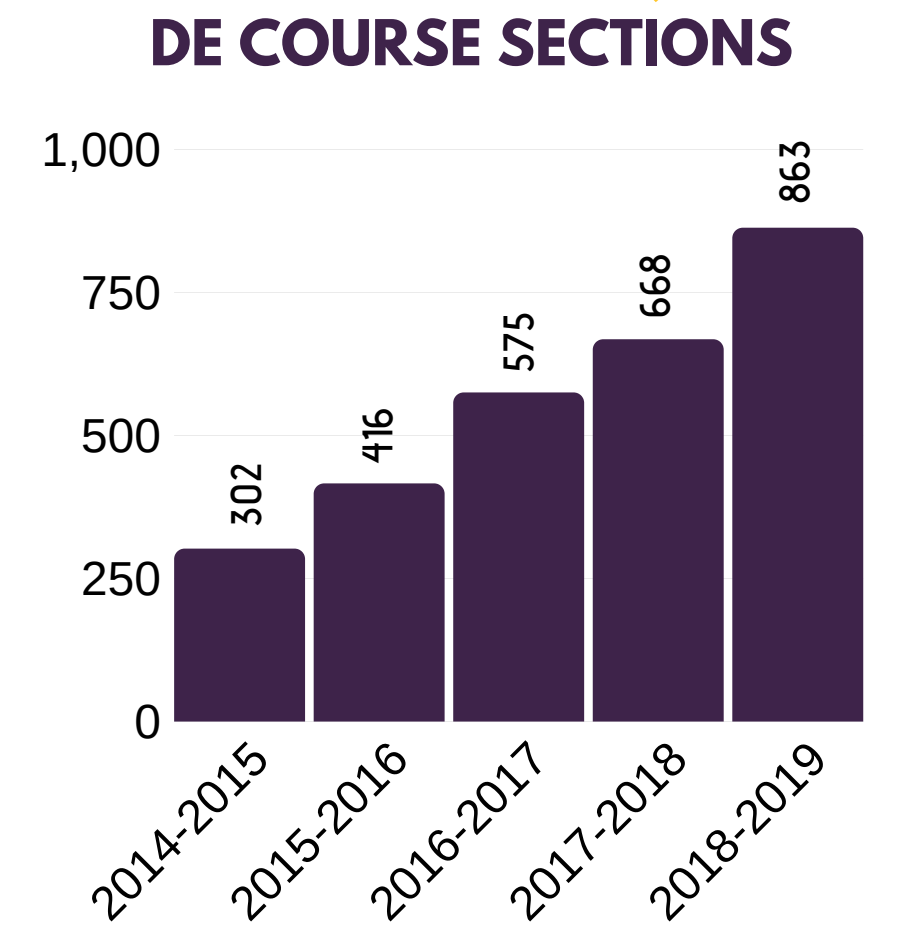
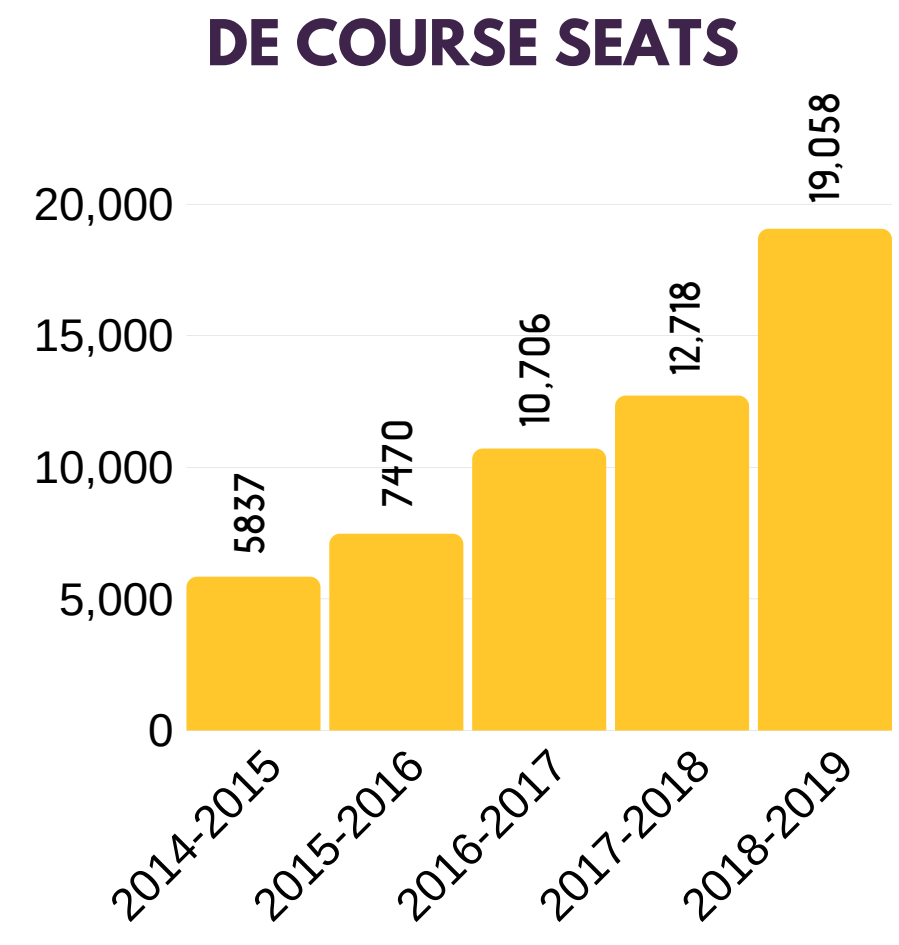

The Office of Distance Education continues to support a growing number of online courses, faculty and students. Over 480 faculty have participated in our CAPC mandated training, with 94 attended last year alone. We also implemented Quality Matters(QM) and eTextbook Initiatives. QM provides nationally recognized benchmarks for online course and program design standards. The eTextbook Initiative offers to replace and/or supplement expensive textbooks with free, faculty-produced electronic versions. We look forward to another successful year of working with faculty and students in online education.
