The overturning of Roe v. Wade via the Dobbs decision sent shockwaves through our nation. The public's response was swift and voices, both for or against the decision, were heard most prominently from Adults. The underrepresented voices of Adolescents and Transition age youth were largely overlooked, much to the detriment of this population. This workshop aims to examine the needs and experiences of Adolescents and Transition age youth via both a historical and present focused lens of reproductive justice and abortion rights in the United States. Participants will explore the sexual health and developmental needs of teens as a foundation for understanding the impact of this landmark decision on their lives and the work of the professionals who serve them. The interactive conversation will raise awareness of both macro & micro level issues and uplift strategies to advocate for the needs of American youth.
