


## SMART Board MX: Creating Student Engagement with IQ Whiteboard Level 2

### POWER ON THE SMART MX IQ WHITEBOARD

1. To turn on the SMART Board, tap the Crestron panel to wake up the display.
2. On the SMART Board, press the *Home* button located at the bottom right corner of the board.
3. The iQ home screen will be displayed > tap the *Whiteboard* tile. This will open a new whiteboard for you to use. To go back to the basics, [see the Level 1 guide](#).


### WHITEBOARD SIDEBAR

The sidebar is where you can go through your slide deck, add new pages, and create interactive lessons.


- To move through your slide deck, press the up and down arrows at the bottom left-hand corner or tap on the numbered rectangle in the middle to see all your slides.
- To insert a graphic organizer: Tap  to add a ready-made activity after the current page. Select *Graphic Organizer* or *Manipulative*. Tap the ready-made activity you want to add to the file. You can also add a new blank page by tapping *Blank Page* at the top.

### STUDENT INTERACTIVITY

Shout It Out is a great way to engage your class, check for understanding, brainstorm, and share goals! To add a Shout It out page:

1. Browse to a page, tap  and select **Shout It Out!** to add the activity after the current page.
2. Have students enter [helloSMART.com](https://helloSMART.com) in their web browsers or scan the QR code on the display. Have them select your class to join the activity.
3. Tap *Start* on the SMART Board display to begin the Shout It Out! activity and have students use their devices to contribute.

Students can also collaborate on a class Whiteboard. To set this up:

1. Browse to a page, tap  and select **Whole Class page** to add the activity after the current page.
2. Have students enter [helloSMART.com](https://helloSMART.com) in their web browsers or scan the QR code on the display. Have them select your class to join the activity.
3. By default, all connected participants can add and edit content on the screen. To restrict editing to the host, select the Everyone can edit toggle.
