<u>IMPORTANT ADVISING INFORMATION</u>: Advisors are assigned to all students. Advising appointments are needed to help students make appropriate elective choices and plan for core course sequencing. Advisors meet with students during scheduled office hours or through appointments. It is important to note that advisors are not always available during the summer months and advising issues may not be resolved immediately, therefore it is important for students to schedule advising appointments during fall/spring semesters.

<u>Writing Emphasis Courses.</u> Three writing emphasis courses (W) are required if a student transfers less than 40 credits; two courses are required if 40-70 credits are transferred; and one is required if more than 70 credits are transferred. W courses do not transfer in. At least one W course must be at the 300 or 400 level. HEA310 (Love & Marriage), HEA315 (Mind, Body Health), <u>OR</u> HEA345 (Public Health & the Apocalypse) is recommended.

Speaking Emphasis Courses. Transfer students with fewer than 40-college level credits must complete 9 credits of Speaking Emphasis. Students with 40-70 credits must complete 6 credits of Speaking Emphasis. Students with more than 70 credits must take 3 credits of Speaking Emphasis at the 300-400 level. SPK199, SPK208, or SPK230 is recommended.

Ethics Course. Students are required to complete a 3 credits 'ethics designated' (E) course. HEA300 is recommended.

<u>Interdisciplinary Course.</u> One interdisciplinary course (I) is required. ENV102 (Humans and the Environment) is recommended.

<u>Diverse Communities Course.</u> One diverse communities course (J) is required. Either HEA110 (Transcultural Health); or HEA109 (Health Issues of Women) is recommended.
