## NTD GRADE REQUIREMENTS

- A "C" or better grade is required in all NTD courses and MAT121, ECO111, ACC201, and MKT250.
- If any core or cognate courses have prerequisites, the minimum grade requirements for those prerequisites must be met before the core or cognate course can be taken.
- Transfer courses need to meet these grade requirements to transfer to WCU.

## NOTES:

- BIO 110 can substitute for BIO 100.
- Apply online for graduation no later than the end of the junior year or when 90 credits have been earned.
- It is suggested that students work 400-800 hours in food management and/or sustainability before graduating. This allows students to gain broad experience in the field and find out what interests them most. It will also provide them with a potential reference and their experience will allow them to enter the field beyond an entry-level position.
