How do I receive Financial Aid to help me pay for my program?

- Every student should fill out the FAFSA to qualify for aid at WCU that may be used to study abroad: <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa>

Can my Financial Aid be used for my Study Abroad program?

- Typically, yes! It all depends on how many credits will be earned on your program.

Are there any scholarship opportunities to help with paying for Study Abroad?

Will my scholarship that I have be able to be used for going abroad?

- This will depend on the type of scholarship that you have and how many credits you will earn on the program.

Can I use my refund money to help pay for any extra expenses such as excursions?

- Absolutely! Your refund money can be used for any expenses you have on the program.

Can I take out a loan to help pay for my program if I do not qualify for any scholarships?

- Yes! Depending on the number of credits offered on the program, you may be eligible to apply for a student loan to help pay for the expenses.
