This program is geared toward students currently enrolled in a music degree program. Students in other degree programs may be admitted with permission from the School of Music. Students must have the permission of both their major advisor, the Chair of the Applied Music Department (Dr. Chris Hanning) and the Jazz Studies Coordinator. Students must submit an Application for Minor form (http://www.wcupa.edu/registrar/forms.asp). The Minor field in Music provides a program of 18 credits of study as follows:

AJZ 362 (3 cr.) Jazz Musicianship and Improvisation II (spring semester only)
MHL 422 (3 cr.) History of Jazz
AJZ 365 (3 cr.) Jazz Techniques
*AES 151 (0.5 cr.) Jazz Ensemble (Criterions) (2 semesters)
AES 152 (0.5 cr.) Jazz Ensemble (Combo) (2 semesters)
