This program is geared toward any WCU student interested in music. To be enrolled, students must have the permission of both their major advisor and the School of Music, having successfully passed an ensemble audition. Students must complete an ensemble audition and submit an Application for Minor form (http://www.wcupa.edu/registrar/forms.aspx). The Minor field in Music provides a program of 18 credits of study as follows:

MTC 111 (3 cr.) The Developing Musician (spring semester only; prerequisite: MTC 110)

3 credits of Music History chosen from:

AEB 311 (1 cr.) Marching Band

AEB 341 (0.5 cr.) Wind Ensemble

AEO 341 (0.5 cr.) Symphony Orchestra

AES 131 (0.5 cr.) Guitar Ensemble

PIA 181 (1 cr.) Piano Class I for non-majors

ASC 196 (0.5 cr.) Guitar Class

Music Electives (6-6.5 credits)

Any music course, selected under advisement, for which the student meets the prerequisite. This may include up to four semesters of vocal, keyboard, or instrumental lessons by permission of the Chair of Applied Music (Dr. Chris Hanning). If a student takes the maximum number of private lessons allowed at least one of the course numbers must be above the beginning level. It is recommended that students enroll in two additional 3-credit theory, history, or aurals courses to satisfy this requirement.
