Parental Monitoring of Children

WCU Community Mental Health Services should be a friendly and welcoming place for children and families. To ensure the safety of children who are seen by WCU CMHS, we ask that parents/guardians follow these guidelines:

- 1. Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times except during individual sessions between the therapist and the child.
- 2. Parents are responsible for waiting with their children in the waiting room until the child's clinician arrives. Children must not be dropped off or picked up outside the building.
- 3. Children must sit or play quietly while in the waiting room. They should not be left unattended and/or without a clinician or parent present.
- 4. It is recommended that parents remain in the waiting area until the child's session is over. However, if parents must leave for any reason, the child's clinician should be informed, contact information should be obtained, and the parent should return before the session is over.
