The West Chester University Psychology Department invites applications for the Psychology Undergraduate Merit Scholarship. The scholarship is a \$500 award created for the junior-level Psychology major who excels academically.

Application Requirements: Applications are due to the Psychology department (submitted electronically to psych@wcupa.edu) each fall semester (deadline for this year is listed on the application). Eligibility is limited to junior-level Psychology majors who meet specific course completion and GPA requirements (see application for specifics). Application materials include the application form (see attached), a CV or resume listing academic and extra-curricular achievements, and a 250-word essay describing why you are applying for the scholarship. In addition, one letter of recommendation from a Psychology department faculty member must be forwarded to the scholarship committee.
