To assure that 80% of all participants will remain in good academic standing by meeting the performance standards at West Chester University	Number and percentage of each cohort who have met the objective; student rosters; student transcripts; advising evaluation; final grades; student evaluations	Analysis of students' grade reports and transcripts; compilation of retention data based on transcript analysis; analysis and summary of end-of-semester evaluation results	At the end of 2012-2013 cohort's year, 95% were in good academic standing Academic Dismissal = 1% Academic Probation = 4% G.P.A. < 2.0 = 10% G.P.A. 2.0-2.99 = 38% G.P.A. 3.00-3.99 = 51% G.P.A. 4.0 = 1%
